How do I tell someone what I like to do as a hobby?

Use any of the following sentence patterns in order to tell someone what you like to do as a hobby:

Ich + AKTIVITÄT + in meiner Freizeit. (*I like to + ACTIVITY + in my free time.*)

Ich spiele gerne Fußball in meiner Freizeit. (I like to play soccer in my free time.)

Ich lese gerne in meiner Freizeit. (I like to read in my free time.)

Ich spiele gerne Videospiele in meiner Freizeit. (I like to play video games in my free time.)

Ich mag es, + AKTIVITÄT. (*I like + ACTIVITY.*)

Ich mag es, fern zu sehen. (I like watching TV.)

Ich mag es, zu schreiben. (I like writing stories.)

Ich mag es, Fußball zu spielen. (I like playing soccer.)

Ich liebe es, + Aktivität. (*I love to + ACTIVITY.*)

Ich liebe es, Gitarre zu spielen. (I love to play guitar.)

Ich liebe es, Musik zu hören. (I love to listen to music.)

Ich liebe es, zu zeichnen. (I love to draw.)

How do I talk about the things I'm interested in?

You can tell someone what you're interested in by using either of the following sentence patterns:

Ich interessiere mich für + SACHE. (*I'm interested in + THING.*)

Ich interessiere mich für Fremdsprachen. (I'm interested in foreign languages.)

Ich interessiere mich für Punkmusik. (I'm interested in punk music.)

Ich interessiere mich für Geschichte. (I'm interested in history.)

Ich stehe auf + SACHE. (*I'm into + THING.*)

Ich stehe auf Horrorfilme. (I'm into horror movies.)

Ich stehe auf Videospiele. (I'm into video games.)

Ich stehe auf klassische Musik. (I'm into classical music.)
