How common are taxis in German-speaking countries?

Taxis are fairly common in major cities throughout the German-speaking world. You'll most likely find them around a city's center. Although, most people travel by public transportation, bike, or with their own car. Outside of cities, or on their outskirts, taxis are much less common.

What do taxis look like in German-speaking countries?

Taxi cars can look different from city to city and country to country. In Germany for example, they are often a light yellow, beige, or white color. Taxi drivers also attach a little taxi sign to their roofs, so you can easily identify them.

How much do you tip a taxi driver in the German-speaking world?

Happy with how your taxi ride went? Normally, you would tip a German taxi driver similarly to how you tip a waiter or waitress at a restaurant. That means tips are usually 10-15% of what your fare costs.

How do I tell a German-speaking taxi driver where I want to go?

Here are some different ways to tell a taxi driver where you want to go:

Ich muss zu + ORT. (*I need to get to + PLACE.*)

Ich muss zum Flughafen. (*I need to get to the airport.*)

Ich muss zur Universität. (*I need to get to the university.*)

Ich muss zu dieser Adresse. (*I need to get to this address.*)

Können Sie mich zu + ORT + fahren? (*Can you take me to + PLACE?*)

Können Sie mich zur Bibliothek in der Rosenstraße fahren? (*Can you take me to the library on Rose Street?*)

Können Sie mich zu dieser Adresse fahren? (*Can you take me to this address?*)

Können Sie mich zu dem Café in der Eichenstraße fahren? (*Can you take me to the café on Oak Street?*)

Können Sie mich + ORT + absetzen? (*Can you drop me off + PLACE?*)

Können Sie mich im Stadtzentrum absetzen? (*Can you drop me off in the city center?*)

Können Sie mich am Campus der Universität absetzen? (*Can you drop me off at the university campus?*)

Können Sie mich an der Ecke zur Hauptstraße absetzen? (*Can you drop me off at the corner of Main Street?*)
