Complimenting someone is a great way to start flirting with them. Compliments about someone's abilities or appearance are especially great. There are lots of ways someone could respond to a sentence like this. Here is one example [Thanks, I like yours too.](#)

Are you seeing anyone?

This is one of the most common ways to ask somebody if they are already dating someone. Alternatively, you could also just ask [Are you single?](#). Depending on whether or not the other person is already in a relationship, they may respond in a number of ways. For example like this [Yes, I already have a boyfriend.](#)

Responding to Flirting

If you find someone flirting with you, then there's lots of different ways to respond. How you answer will depend on how you feel about the other person. Below, we'll introduce you to different phrases that can help you do this.

I'm sorry, but I'm not interested.
I'm already seeing someone.
I had a great time with you.
You're so funny.
Let's exchange numbers.
We should get together again sometime.
I'd love to meet up again sometime.
I'd really like to see you again.
I really enjoyed talking to you.
Please leave me alone.
Get lost!

I'm already seeing someone

Use this sentence if you want to tell someone that you are already in a relationship. You could also say [I already have a boyfriend](#) or [I already have a girlfriend](#). This sentence could also be used to get someone to stop flirting with you if you're not interested in them. In response, someone might say something like [Oh, sorry!](#).

Get lost!

This sentence can be used to tell someone to leave you alone. Use it if someone flirting with you is being too pushy or aggressive and you want them to go away.
